- Able to commit to the full length of the program regardless of work status.

# How it works.

- The *Women Building Australia* National Mentoring Program provides an e-mentoring service. Face to face mentoring interaction can also occur.
- The program is nine months in duration.
- You will be expected to be in contact with your mentor at least monthly, either face-to-face or virtually, depending on location and personal preference.
- You will complete an online training program provided by Art of Mentoring ([artofmentoring.net](http://artofmentoring.net)) to prepare you for the program.
- You will be required to attend three 1-hour webinars over the nine month mentoring program - Program Launch, Progress Review, and Review at Program Close.
